"Nat can pick a dog," said Mom.


Nat picks a big, black dog.


The following terms should be used in recording the condition of the book: New; Good; Fair; Poor; Bad.

Zack is Nat's best friend. Can Zack help Nat spell? No!




Nat can toss a stick.

"You can not go," he said to Zack.




"Zack ran off," said Dad.
