


A cave is a big hole. It can be in a hill. We can go into this cave.

The following terms should be used in recording the condition of the book: New; Good; Fair; Poor; Bad.




Caves are dim and damp.
You must be safe. You should have a lamp.




A cave has lots of paths. Look at the map. This map has five paths.



Pick one path. Take a rope with you. Give the rope to your friend.




A cave can have a lake. Fish can live in the lake. You can dive in the lake.
