


This part of the country has snowy winters. It has hot summers. The Atlantic is cool here. Lobsters like the cool sea.




The Pilgrims landed in 1620. That was hundreds of years ago.



Look at this part of the country. The sunshine is constant here! You can swim in summer. You can swim in winter too!


