





Teachers should see that the pupil's name is clearly written in ink in the spaces above in every book issued.



he be in danger?




Phil races down to the river. He sees a large barge. Phil jumps onto the barge and takes a trip!




Inside the barge there is a huge stage!


Phil steps onto this large stage. Once he's on stage, he starts to sing.




"Sing more, sing more!"
